On March 10, 2018 Central Valley Aviation Association and EAA Chapter 376 will host and honor Colonel Bud Anderson, WWII Fighter Pilot and Triple Ace (16 ¼ Aerial Victories) flying his P-51, “Old Crow.” His squadron, the 363rd, included another Ace, Chuck Yeager.

Old Crow carried Anderson safely through 116 missions without being hit by fire from enemy aircraft or having to turn back for any reason. After the war, Anderson became a well-regarded fighter test pilot, and a fighter squadron and wing commander. He served his wing commander tour in combat in the Vietnam War. He retired as a full colonel in 1972, after which he worked in flight test management for McDonnell Douglas. He is a member of the National Aviation Hall of Fame.
